## STUDENTS RETURNING TO CAMPUS AND CONDUCT OF COURSES FOR SEMESTER II 2020/2021

*Assalamualaikum and Salam Sejahtera,*

1. In a press statement dated 31 Dec 2020, YB Datuk Seri Dr. Noraini Ahmad, Minister of Higher Education has announced that :
  - a) Students in IHL will be allowed to return to campus to resume their studies starting from 1 March 2021.
  - b) Students from red zones are required to undergo a 10-day isolation at a designated facility on campus before they can resume their studies. These students are required to return to campus in mid February 2021 to undergo the 10-day isolation.
  - c) International students are allowed to return to Malaysia to resume their studies from 1 Jan 2021. They are required to follow EMGS procedure strictly, which include doing a Covid19 RT-PCR test and undergoing quarantine at designated quarantine station, before they can return to campus.
2. In order to comply with the SOP stipulated by MOHE, the Teaching & Learning (T&L) delivery in Sem II 2020/2021 will be a hybrid between Virtual Learning (VL) and Face to Face (F2F). All lectures will be VL whereas labs and projects will be F2F.
3. For labs and projects, the delivery will take place via VL at the start of Sem II 2020/21, followed by F2F from the week of 1 March 2021. The F2F labs, projects and consultation will be subjected to strict compliance to relevant SOPs as stipulated by MOHE and UNITEN.
4. Course assessment will be a hybrid covering online summative assessment, online alternative assessment, lab reports, project reports, presentations, etc.
5. All campus facilities - sport facilities, library, student centre, etc. - will be accessible to all students from 1 March 2021.



6. The arrangement for students to return to campus accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan* are as follows:
- a) Students from red zones are required to undergo a 10-day isolation at *Kelompok Ilmu* (For Putrajaya Campus) and *Kelompok Bestari* (For KSHAS) starting from 17 Feb 2021. After the isolation period, students will be allowed to check-in to their respective accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan*.
  - b) Students from non-red zones are allowed to check-in to their respective accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan* starting from 27 February 2021.
  - c) Returning international students are allowed to check-in to their respective accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan* after they complete their quarantine upon arrival in Malaysia.
  - d) The Accommodation Unit of HEP will email students a set of detailed SOPs which need be adhered strictly when returning to accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan*.
7. Students are highly encouraged to stay in campus accommodation/*Kelompok Penginapan* to ensure uninterrupted learning, convenient communication with lecturers and easy access to all university facilities.
