Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for Higher Education Institutions	To allow the entry of students to continue their studies physically at their respective education institutions	Info
Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) on Entry of International Students to Malaysia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. All international students (except from United Kingdom) ii. Comply ruling of mandatory quarantine of seven (7) or ten (10) days before entering campus ii. Applicable for both for new and existing student 	Info: Dependent pass are still not allowed to enter Malaysia until further notices
Update on eVAL Extension	Those students with (eVAL) has expired since March 2020 due to Movement Control Order (MCO) .	Allow the extension of eVAL that has expired during the Movement Control Order (MCO) period
Pre-Arrival Process for New Students	Once EVAL approved, eVAL and the Travel Authorization will be auto-generated and made available for download through EMGS Website	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Travel Authorization can be downloaded from the following link below https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/emgs/application/searchForm/ ii. Download, fill and sign the Letter of Undertaking and Indemnity (LOU) and obtain the travel notice from the nearest Malaysian Mission office. https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/guidelines/travel-authorisation-form-base.html

Single Entry Visa (SEV)	Students from countries that requires Single-Entry Visa (SEV) to enter Malaysia are required to submit their SEV application to the nearest Malaysian Mission office	Info
Entry Point at Malaysia	KLIA & KLIA 2 only	Info
RT-PCR Covid-19 Test	Students are required to undergo the RT-PCR Covid-19 Test three (3) days before travelling to Malaysia.	10-days (without valid RT-PCR results upon arrival) or Shortening of the quarantine period to 7-days (with valid RT-PCR results upon arrival)
RT-PCR Covid-19 Test (Information)	Fees imposed by the Government of Malaysia i. Covid-19 detection test ii. Quarantine cost iii. Hospital admittance fee (if required)	Borne by the international student
TOTAL FEES	i. Charges for covid-19 screening test at international entry ii. Fixed Charges (Quarantine Station Operations) iii. Quarantine Cost Accommodation Cost (RM150.00/day)	RM250.00 (RT-PCR) RM120.00 (RTK ANTIGEN) RM2,600.00 RM1,500.00 (10 days of quarantine) RM1,050.00 (7 days of quarantine)
DURING THE QUARANTINE PERIOD	7 days of quarantine 10 days of quarantine	RT-PCR/RTK Ag COVID-19 swab test on the 5 th day of the quarantine period RT-PCR/RTK Ag COVID-19 swab test on the 8 th day of the quarantine period

STUDENT'S ACTION AFTER RECEIVING 'RELEASE ORDER'	Contact Mr Zammany (International Office) at 011-11379414	For the arrangement of pick up at quarantine center.
PASSPORT VALIDITY OF 18 MONTHS FOR eVAL EXTENSION & RENEWAL OF STUDENT VISA	Students must ensure there is a remaining validity of 18 months on their passport.	EMGS will not proceed to submit an application or continue the process unless student renew his/her passport first.
