- d. Other qualifications equivalent to a Bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 as accepted by the HEP Senate; or
- e. A bachelor's degree in accounting or a related field below a CGPA of 2.50 can be accepted, subject to a minimum of 5 years of working experience in the relevant field.
- f. For international students: Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 550 or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0 or its equivalent.
