Entry Requirements

- f. A bachelor's degree in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the HEP Senate and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses; or vii. Other qualifications equivalent to a Bachelor's degree recognized by the Malaysian Government.
- g. For international students: Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 550 or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0 or its equivalent.
